

EARNING CEUS ON GLRSN CALLS



The Great Lakes Regional Stroke Network is pleased to be able to provide CEU for nurses on quality of care calls whenever possible. If you are requesting CEUs, please acquaint yourself with this process.

Question: Do I need to register?

Yes. ALL participants, whether you want CEUs or not, MUST register for all GLRSN calls. This ensures that we have adequate phone lines and helps us report back to our funders.

Question: How do I register?

Go to <http://glrsn.uic.edu>. Under the "Upcoming Events" section of the Home Page, will be a listing of the upcoming Quality of Care calls. Click on the registration button. A registration screen will appear. Complete this screen and click the "submit" button. You will then receive a confirmatory email with the dial in number and additional information.



What information do I need to provide when I register?

All of the fields on the registration screen are required. Effective immediately, if we do not have your complete name, address including city, state and zip as well as phone number and email, we will not be able to issue a CEU certificate as required by the grantor of CEUs, Oakton Community College.

What if I don't know how many people will attend?

This is fine and frequently happens. However, please note that CEU certificates can only be issued for people who provide complete registration information.

Where do I get the speaker's presentation and handouts?

We strive to have the actual presentation and handouts on the GLRSN website (<http://glrsn.uic.edu>) homepage at least one week prior to the call. However, we are dependent on the speakers getting their presentations to us in a timely manner in order to do this. Frequently, we do not get the presentations that far in advance. My best suggestion would be to check the GLRSN website frequently at <http://glrsn.uic.edu>. At times, speakers may refer to slides or handouts that they have not provided. We make every effort to get these materials from the speakers.

How many CEUs will I get?

Are SLP, OT, PT CEUs also available?

At this time, we are only able to offer nursing CEUs. We understand that frequently if one professional organization provides CEUs, it is likely they will be accepted from another professional organi-

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zation. However, this varies, so please check with your state's professional credentialing organization.

How do I get CEUs?

After the call, a link on the GLRSN website homepage (<http://glrsn.uic.edu>) will appear connecting you to the survey on survey monkey. Once you have completed the brief online survey, send an email to hedworth@uic.edu saying that you have completed the evaluation. You will be issued a CEU certificate within 30 days via email.

Every attempt is made to send an email to all participants with the link in the email as well. However, as not everyone provides email addresses, this is very challenging. Therefore, if you have not received an email with the address in 72 hours, go to the website (<http://glrsn.uic.edu>), click on the link to the evaluation and then send an email to hedworth@uic.edu saying that you have completed the evaluation.

The call has been over for 3 days and I still don't have my email with the link to the evaluation. What do I do?

Go to the website at <http://glrsn.uic.edu> and click on the link for the evaluation. Once you have completed the evaluation, send an email to hedworth@uic.edu.

We had several people sitting in on the call. They did not register. Can they get CEUs?

Yes. They will need to send in their complete contact information including complete name, address including city, state and zip as well as phone number and email. They also should go to the website, follow the link to the evaluation and send an email to hedworth@uic.edu when completed. Once their participation on the call is confirmed, they will receive a certificate.



What if I do not have a work email?

You may use a personal email for communication purposes. It will not be shared.

I have a group of people listening to the call. They do not have internet access to complete an evaluation. What do I do?

In extreme circumstances like this, arrangements can be made with the GLRSN Program Manager to provide paper copies of the evaluation to you ahead of time and have your participants complete the evaluation right after the call. Contact Angela at hedworth@uic.edu for more information.

How soon after the call may I request CEUs?

As soon as possible, no later than 30 days.
