

❑ **Establish your NetID and Enterprise ID**

You'll need your Net and Enterprise ID to access my.UIC.edu , the university's portal, where you can complete important steps toward enrollment and find more information that will help you make your decision about whether to attend. To get started go to: www.admissions.uic.edu/admitted

❑ **Log in to my.UIC.edu web portal**

Once you've established your Net and Enterprise ID log onto my.UIC.edu under the 'Existing Portal Users' section. my.UIC will assist you through the admission to enrollment and graduation process. At this one convenient online location, you can access your placement test registration, housing application, financial aid information, Intent to Enroll response, and much more. Go to the my.UIC.edu website and follow the directions under "Newly Admitted Students" to establish and access your account: my.UIC.edu

❑ **Submit your Intent to Enroll Decision**

In order to secure your place at UIC, you must submit your Intent to Enroll (ITE) decision as soon as possible or by May 1st. You may mail or fax your response, but the preferred option is submitting your ITE response at: my.UIC.edu

❑ **Register for Placement Tests**

Most freshmen are required to take placement tests. Register for your placement tests at my.UIC.edu. For detailed information regarding placement tests go to <http://pep.testing.uic.edu>

❑ **Apply for Financial Aid**

To be considered for Financial Aid, you must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) which can be found at www.fafsa.ed.gov . Please note that the FAFSA priority deadline is March 1st.

❑ **Apply for Campus Housing**

If you want to live on campus, it is important to apply early. The Priority deadline is March 15th. Please use the online campus housing application which can be found at www.housing.uic.edu/apply.

❑ **Register for and Attend New Student Orientation**

Only after submitting your Intent to Enroll decision, you will receive more information about Orientation. During Orientation, you will meet with an academic advisor and register for your classes. www.orientation.uic.edu

❑ **Send Final Academic Transcripts and Return the Medical Immunization Form**

Your final academic transcripts and proof of medical immunization (only if you plan to live on campus) are required to begin classes in the fall.
